

Project suggestions – in no particular order:

The Beeches (Lower Playing Field)

- 1/ An all-ages meeting/get-together area, with better seating and or tables, together with planted garden space on the Bridport model.
- 2/ Doubling the size of the children's Fort to make it more challenging and varied for children aged 8 - 12.
- 3/ Doubling size of the children's swing to accommodate two chairs side by side for 'conversational' swinging.

Andover Road Playing Field

- 4/ Levelling off of existing, hazardous, asphalt play area to create viable all-weather surface for multi-sport use by all age groups.
- 5/ **Outdoor gym equipment**
- 6/ **Bike and skateboard track with ramps.**
- 7/ **Zip wire towers.**
- 8/ Clubhouse with shower, storage and changing facilities to replace what might have been offered by the Old School. To suit all ages and encourage greater use of our sloping, Sport England listed soccer pitch. **NB would almost certainly cost more than UPC funds alone could support, but sponsors might be found.**
- 9/ Tied in with 8 – a kids' forum (14 – 18?) in liaison, perhaps, with The Blue Bus; handing kids responsibility for clubhouse activities, maintenance, etc. (Fostering greater civic awareness)
- 10/ Given the hugely popular success of last year's Coronation fair, an annual Midsummer Fair and family sports event.
- 11/ St. Mary's Church – contribution to installation of toilet facilities.
- 12/ Geese – safe infrastructure and care
