

UPAVON PARISH MEETING – WEDNESDAY 18th MAY 2016

TRENCHARD LINES – COMMANDING OFFICER'S REPORT

1. The Commanding Officer of Trenchard Lines, Lieutenant Colonel Grant Ingleton, sends his apologies that he is unable to attend the Upavon Annual Parish Meeting. He is attending a School Governors' Meeting which has been planned for some time. He has sent a short Report/Update as follows:

- **Army Re-Basing.** The '2020 Army Re-Basing Plan' is still moving ahead, with no change to the possible stated time of 2018 at Trenchard Lines, Upavon. Efforts are continuing to secure early funding, in order to improve the entry and exit points to Upavon Station. This work is the Commanding Officer's number one priority.
- **Refurbished Tank Crossing.** The tank crossing closest to Upavon has been refurbished, and the road in proximity upgraded. It is hoped that this work will have a positive effect in easing the amount of traffic passing through Upavon Village.
- **Speed Awareness.** In order to help reduce speeding within the Station, two Speed Indicator signs have been purchased: there has been a marked decrease in speeding around the camp already. Should further SpeedWatch operations be carried out on the A342 in proximity of Trenchard Lines, Station Staff will assist in the deployment of one of the signs onto the A342.
