Police report 18th March 2015

Since your last Parish Council meeting on the 14th January there has been only one reported crime and one traffic related matter in your Parish:

Public Order Offence – Upavon

On the 13th March a lady was verbally abused by her neighbour outside the petrol station in Upavon. This is part of a long-running dispute which is currently being investigated.

Failing to Stop at the scene of a collision – A342, Andover Road

In the early hours of 15th February a member of the public attempted to stop a vehicle, believing that the driver might have been drinking. The vehicle failed to stop and clipped the leg of the member of the public which caused no lasting injury.

This matter is currently being investigated.

In other Pewsey West villages, in the last month, the following crimes have been reported:

Theft – Rushall

Between the 19th and 22nd February 2015 unknown suspects have removed a planted barrel pot from the entrance to the village. It is believed the suspects have used a tractor to move this due to the marks left.

A second pot was removed on the 26th February.

Burglary – Chirton

Between 2nd and 4th March 2015 Unknown suspect(s) have gained entry into a secure shed by unknown means. Nothing was taken from within.

Theft – Rushall

Between the 9th and 28th February 2015 Unknown suspect has removed approximately 50 gallons of heating oil from tank outside of village hall.
